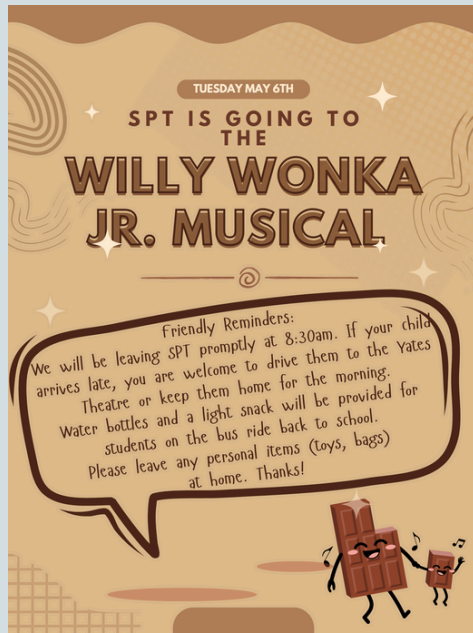

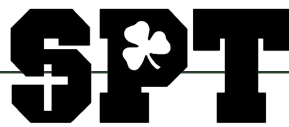

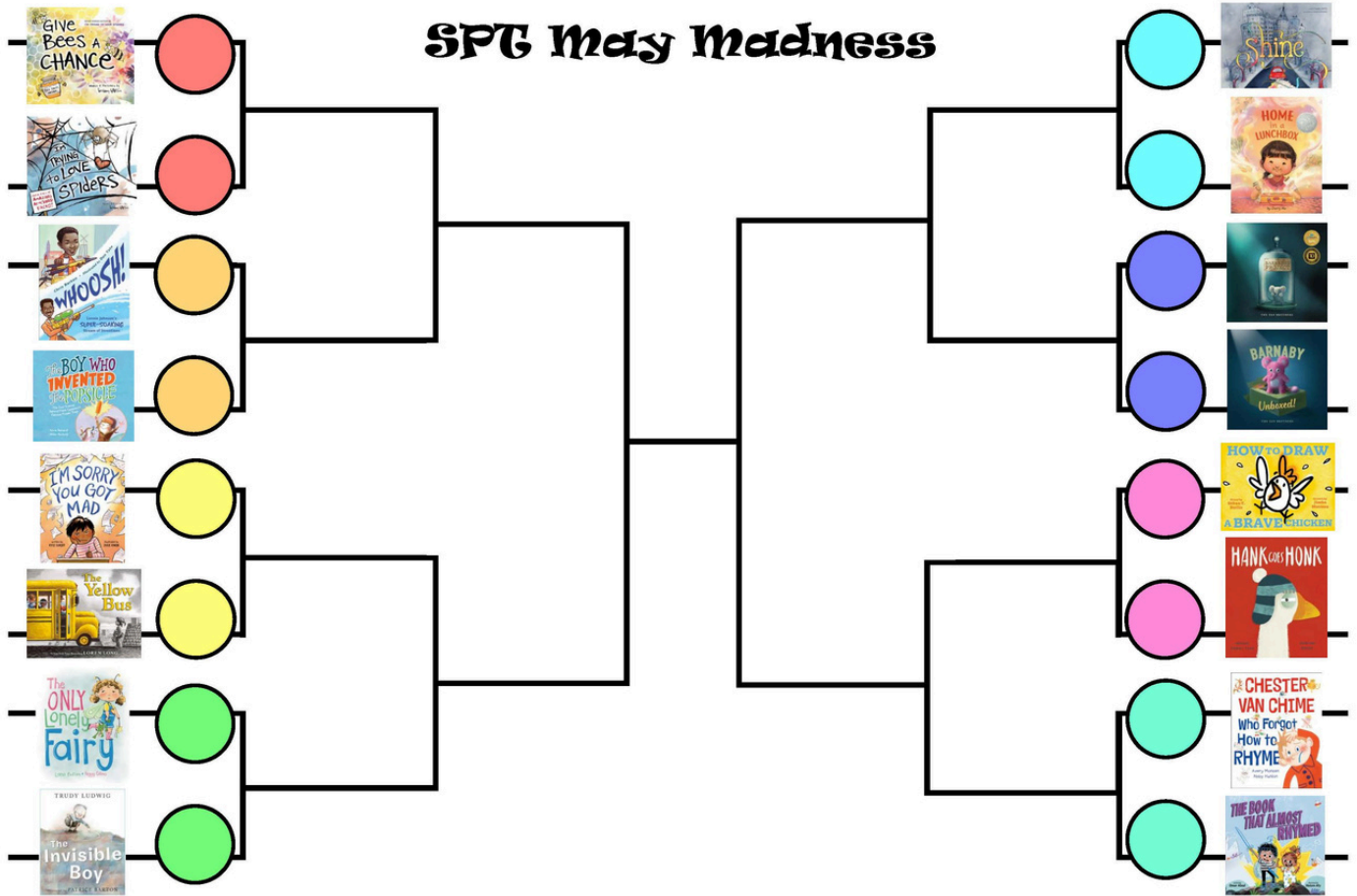


Thank you to all those who participated in our Lenten Dollar Days. We have raised \$662.86 for St. Odilla School through Chalice.

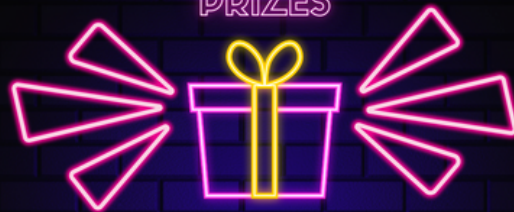
