




2024-2025 Year-End Summative Reports

Assessment is an ongoing process that occurs daily in all our classrooms. SpacesEDU serves as a communication tool to share both progress and growth throughout the school year. Parents/guardians are encouraged to review their child's SpacesEDU portfolio and celebrate the amazing success and growth documented throughout the year. As a summary of learning, your child's teacher has thoughtfully prepared a year-end summative report that highlights not only the progress shown over this school year but also articulates some goals and areas for continued growth as your child continues in their learning journey. This year-end report will be shared via SpacesEDU on the last day of school (Wednesday, June 25, 2025).

Access the Reporting Space & Year-End Summative Report:




The Reporting Space will be visible from June 25 until August 14, 2025.

Student's 'All Work Feed'

Your child's SpacesEDU account provides access to ALL of the student's work, posts, activities, and summative reports for all of their years using SpacesEDU via the 'All Work Feed'. Even after August 14, when classes are archived, your child's account will still maintain access to everything. To access any past posts, activities, or summative reports, have your child log in to their SpacesEDU account and click on 'All Work Feed'.
